RE: FIRE TRAIL ACCESS – DEUA NATIONAL PARK

Due to the ongoing dry conditions, the Merricumbene and Dry Creek Fire Trails currently have steep, loose and impassable sections when traversing from the north to south (from Araluen Road onto Dry Creek Fire Trail, along Merricumbene Fire Trail and onto Bendethera Fire Trail).

If visitors wish to drive along these fire trails, we ask that they traverse from the south to north (Bendethera Fire Trail along the Merricumbene Fire Trail to Dry Creek Fire Trail and onto Araluen Road). This will assist in reducing the further deterioration of these trails until remedial works are undertaken.
