RE: DEUA AND MONGA NPs

Due to recent heavy rainfall and further forecast wet weather over the next 24-48 hours we are advising the public that 4WD trails in Deua and Monga NPs may become impassable.

Sections of Little Sugarloaf Rd have been damaged by recent heavy rain and verges are soft and susceptible to further damage. NPWS advises to drive with caution at all times.

Many creeks and rivers are still in flood and crossings may not be safe to enter. We advise to avoid visiting the Bendethera area over this weekend as river levels may rise with forecast rain.
